

## **RESOLUTION: CREATION OF LAW STUDENT DIVISION**

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Delegates of the Oklahoma Bar Association that Article II of the Rules Creating and Controlling the Oklahoma Bar Association be amended by adding a new subsection:

### **Section 1.A: Affiliation**

Law Students who are currently enrolled in a law school accredited by the American Bar Association may affiliate and participate in the Oklahoma Bar Association with limited rights and privileges as provided in the Bylaws of the Association; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that contingent upon approval of the aforementioned proposed change to the Rules Creating and Controlling the Oklahoma Bar Association that section X (B) be added to the Bylaws of the Oklahoma Bar Association; to wit:

### **Law Student Division**

The Law Student Division of the Oklahoma Bar Association shall consist of law student affiliates who are currently enrolled in a law school accredited by the American Bar Association. A law student affiliate shall not hold himself or herself out to the public or imply in any manner whatsoever that he or she is a member of the Association or entitled to practice law in this state. The Association retains the right to deny or revoke the privileges of any law student who violates the Rules or Bylaws of the Association. The Law Student Division shall adopt Bylaws, not inconsistent with the Rules or Bylaws of the Association, which shall prescribe the yearly dues for law student affiliates.
