

HB2506* An Act relating to oil and gas; amending 17 O.S. 2001, Section 180.10, which relates to the Corporation Commission Plugging Fund; amending 68 O.S. 2001, Sections 1101, 1102 and 1103, as amended by Section 2, Chapter 436, O.S.L. 2005 (68 O.S. Supp. 2005, Section 1103), which relate to the petroleum excise tax; extending termination date of plugging fund and petroleum excise tax; granting the Corporation Commission jurisdiction and authority over seeping natural gas; defining seeping natural gas; requiring the Commission to respond and coordinate response efforts; authorizing the Commission to investigate and order abatement of seeping natural gas occurrences; authorizing the Commission to form emergency response teams; creating the Corporation Commission Gas Seep Fund; providing for source of funds; authorizing certain expenditures from fund; allowing certain expenditures for serious environmental emergencies; providing for payment by warrants; requiring the Commission to seek abatement of a seeping natural gas hazard through certain actions; allowing the Commission to expend funds to install certain systems in certain circumstances; allowing the Commission to seek reimbursement of expenditures from responsible persons; providing for deposit of funds; directing the Commission to promulgate rules establishing the eligibility of structure owners for assistance; limiting liability of the Commission for certain damages; limiting liability of certain persons entering land to investigate or abate a seeping natural gas hazard; limiting responsibility of certain persons for future abatement work or damages; clarifying effect of law on legally responsible persons; defining term; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

HB2507* An Act relating to Corporation Commission; amending 17 O.S. 2001, Sections 303, as last amended by Section 1, Chapter 435, O.S.L. 2005, and 304 (17 O.S. Supp. 2005, Section 303), which relate to the Oklahoma Storage Tank Regulation Act; modifying definition; modifying exempt capacity for underground storage tank systems; making certain aboveground storage tanks with certain capacity exempt from the act; modifying limitation for certain exemption; and declaring an emergency.

SB1752* An Act relating to motor carriers; amending Section 1, Chapter 418, O.S.L. 2005 (17 O.S. Supp. 2005, Section 701), which relates to Corporation Commission employee criminal history searches; authorizing certain employees to be fingerprinted; amending 47 O.S. 2001, Section 162.1, which relates to motor carriers; authorizing the Commission to promulgate rules enabling state participation in certain interstate registration system; amending 47 O.S. 2001, Section 172, which relates to violations; authorizing fines to be deposited in certain fund; amending 47 O.S. 2001, Section 180h, which relates to fees; authorizing collection and deposit of certain fees into certain fund; amending 47 O.S. 2001, Section 230.27, which relates to intrastate licenses; authorizing annual renewal for certain time period and deposit into certain fund; amending 47 O.S. 2001, Section 230.33, which relates to overweight vehicles; providing exemptions; amending 47 O.S. 2001, Section 1106, as amended by Section 18, Chapter 390, O.S.L. 2004(47 O.S.
