HB2621* An Act relating to wildlife; creating the Oklahoma Farmed Cervidae Act; providing definitions; authorizing agents of the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry to enter premises for certain purposes; authorizing agent of the Department of Wildlife Conservation to enter and inspect premises for certain purposes; limiting applications of the act; providing for jurisdiction over commercial hunting facilities; authorizing the State Board of Agriculture to promulgate rules and implement fees; stating powers and authority of the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry; prohibiting breeding and possession of cervidae for certain purpose without a license; listing requirements for a farmed cervidae license; providing for application and licensing process; requiring farmed cervidae to be confined in certain manner; allowing for coordination of inspections; directing owners to take reasonable steps to return escaped cervidae; requiring notification of an escape; authorizing the Department of Wildlife Conservation to destroy escaped cervidae; allowing escaped cervidae to be taken; limiting liability; making certain action unlawful and violation of the act; allowing the slaughter of farmed cervidae at any time; allowing the sale or disposal of hides or antlers from slaughtered farmed cervidae; providing for penalty for violation of the act; prohibiting new registration or permit for certain period after cancellation or revocation; providing for penalty for violation of Oklahoma Wildlife Conservation Code; allowing the State Veterinarian to issue emergency orders in certain circumstances; requiring immediate compliance with emergency order; providing for hearing of emergency order; providing for appeal of final order; amending 29 O.S. 2001, Section 3-103, which relates to the powers and duties of the Wildlife Conservation Commission; updating and clarifying statutory language; deleting

regulation requirements of exotic livestock; amending 29 O.S. 2001, Section 3-201, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 287, O.S.L. 2003 (29 O.S.
