Supp. 2005, Section 623), which relates to on-site primary medical treatment programs; authorizing employment of certified medication aides; amending 63 O.S. 2001, Section 1-1950.3, as last amended by Section 12, Chapter 460, O.S.L. 2005 (63 O.S. Supp. 2005, Section 1-1950.3), which relates to nurses and medication aides; allowing certified medication aides to distribute medications in correctional facilities; and declaring an emergency.

Supp. 2005, Section 644), which relates to domestic abuse; modifying scope of treatment or counseling requirement; updating language; amending 21 O.S. 2001, Section 1123, as last amended by Section 1, Chapter 159, O.S.L. 2003 (21 O.S. Supp. 2005, Section 1123), which relates to lewd molestation; increasing certain penalty; modifying language; amending Section 1, Chapter 209, O.S.L. 2003 (21 O.S. Supp. 2005, Section 1125), which relates to safety zone; adding locations to certain safety zone; prohibiting sex offenders from being within certain distance of safety zone; increasing penalties; adding certain exemption; amending 22 O.S. 2001, Section 60.6, as last amended by Section 16, Chapter 348, O.S.L. 2005 (22 O.S.
