

RULES OF THE OBA HOUSE OF DELEGATES:

- a. All non-delegates wishing to address the House shall make written request to the Custodian of Records, to be approved by the House.
- b. In regard to nominations, there will be one nominating speech not to exceed four minutes, one seconding speech not to exceed three minutes, and the candidate may speak not to exceed three minutes.
- c. Regarding proposals submitted to the House, five minutes will be allowed for explanation of a proposal, and speakers against and for the proposal, and in that order, shall alternate with a time limit of three minutes each. The total time allowed for speakers on each side of a proposal shall be limited to fifteen minutes.
- d. All speakers, whether a delegate or not, shall sign a register maintained by the Custodian of Records.
- e. Any amendment to any proposal submitted to the House shall be in writing, signed by the author, and submitted to the Custodian of Records. The total time allowed for speakers on an amendment shall be limited to ten minutes for each side.
- f. Any new proposal to be submitted to the House which has not been considered by the Resolutions Committee shall be in writing, signed by the author, co-signed by at least twenty other members of the House of Delegates, and submitted to the Custodian of Records. Time limitations on new proposals shall be the same as are provided for resolutions submitted by the Resolutions Committee.
