License Terms: As a condition of publication and for no monetary compensation, you hereby grant the OBA the following rights to the Work: (1) exclusive right of first publication of the Work worldwide as part of the above-named medium; (2) nonexclusive worldwide right to reproduce, distribute, sell, perform, and display the Work and to license and syndicate use of the Work, or any part thereof, in any medium or form of communication, now existing or hereafter developed, to others; (3) the nonexclusive worldwide right to use the Work, or any part thereof, in any other medium produced by the OBA, including, but not limited, to: Oklahoma Bar Journal, www.okbar.org, OBA E-News; and (4) OBA shall retain any copyrights, now or hereafter obtained, to the above-named Work. The grant of rights herein shall include, but not be limited to, the right to adapt or otherwise use the Work, or any portion thereof, alone or in conjunction with other materials, in all types of electronic, digital and computer-based media and technologies, now existing or hereafter developed, as well as the storage, retrieval, transmission, display, output and reproduction of data through any such media and technologies.

The OBA shall have the right to edit the Work, provided that the meaning is not materially altered. In addition, you shall assign the nonexclusive worldwide right to use the Work to promote and publicize the OBA or its publications, including the right to use your name and likeness and biographical data in such promotion. Should the Work contain any material which requires written permission for inclusion in the Work, you agree to obtain such permission from the copyright proprietor consistent with this Agreement.

Termination: The OBA shall have the exclusive right to terminate the Agreement as set forth herein. Upon termination of the Agreement, all licenses granted prior to termination shall survive. The warranties described herein shall survive any termination of this Agreement.
