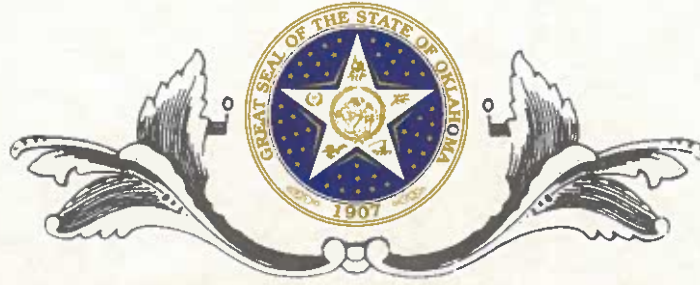

**Whereas**, we the people are also brought together in pursuit of legislative efforts that promote life, liberty, justice and the pursuit of happiness; and

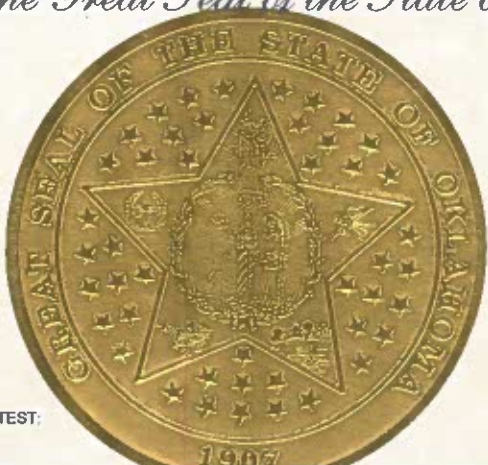
**Whereas**, Law Day activities will be held throughout the State of Oklahoma to promote public understanding of the roots of our freedom;
